My mother, Grandma Margaret, loved the fact that your family was there. She thoroughly enjoyed reading to Megan and Nathan and loved being around them.

The food you serve is excellent and high quality. Mother loved fresh fruits and vegetables and you always have an abundance of both. I liked the fact that you catered to her preferences. She always had a salad for lunch while others preferred something else and had that. I can't count the times we had family dinners at your house with my mom but it was always special and fun. Her 90th birthday was really a highlight when we invited her nieces and their families from Oregon, good friends and all of our families for the fabulous dinner you provided. We all had a great time and Grandma Margaret loved it.
